

## DDP-2 Index, Factor & ISPM Scores

### Index Scores:

- There are 7 Index Scores: Motor, Cognitive, Communication, Self Care, Daily Living, Behavior Frequency, and Behavior Consequences
- Each Index Score can range from 0 to 100. Higher scores indicate higher skills, or fewer limitations.
- DDP-2 items used to create the Index Scores: 20, 22 - 28

### Factor Scores:

- There are 3 Factor Scores: Adaptive, Maladaptive, and Health.
- Adaptive Scores range to 500, Maladaptive to 200, and Health to 31. Higher Scores indicate more limitations.
- Adaptive and Maladaptive Factors are derived from the Index Scores [Maladaptive includes Behavior Frequency and Behavior Consequence; Adaptive includes the other 5 Index Scores]. DDP-2 items used to create the Health Factor: 14-17.

### ISPM Scores:

- ISPM Scores range from 1 through 6: an ISPM of 1 describes people with low behavior support needs and low direct support needs; 2 = high behavior, low direct support; 3 = low behavior, medium direct support; 4 = high behavior, medium direct support; 5 = low behavior, high direct support; 6 = high behavior and high direct support needs.
- ISPM Scores are derived from the Factor Scores. "Direct Support" levels are a function of a person's Adaptive and Health Factors. "Behavioral Support" levels are a function of the person's Maladaptive Factor Score.
